<u>1. 中文教學目標(Chinese Teaching objectives)</u>

課程的主要目的是使學生在寫作方面能夠連貫且清楚地表達、提升英語寫作的流利度、在撰寫不同文章體裁上建立信心並且熟悉學術寫作和研究論文的要點。

<u>2. 英文教學目標(English Teaching objectives)</u>

The aims of the course are to enable students to express themselves coherently and clearly in writing, to increase their fluency in English writing, to build their confidence in composing various types of texts and to familiarize with the essentials for writing academic essays and research papers.

3. 中文教學綱要(Chinese CourseDescription)

Students are asked to identify the textual structure underlying different text types and to understand their social purposes and meanings. This course prepares freshman students for the subsequent writing courses.
