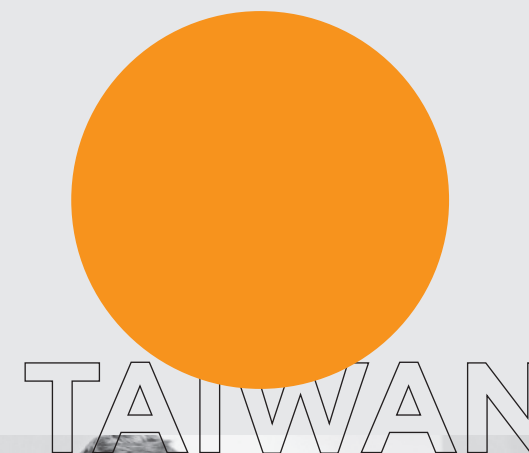

1. Certificate of Nationality (passport)
2. Academic Credentials and Official Transcripts  
(translated in Chinese and English; notarized and authenticated by the ROC embassy, consulate office, or Taipei Economic & Culture Office)
3. An official bank statement  
(should be issued in English/Chinese; dated within the last 3 months)
4. At least one letter of Recommendation.
5. Certificate of English proficiency / Certificate of Mandarin proficiency
6. Other materials required by specific departments/institutes
