### Classes



#### **UK-THEMED LESSONS**

Provide interesting knowledge about UK history, culture, geography, natural history, and more, giving students a chance to consider and share about these aspects of their own countries.

#### **ENGLISH SKILLS COMPONENTS**

Introduce useful language for understanding and discussing the content of the day's lesson.

#### **EXCITING GAMES**

Quiz the students' knowledge of the lesson and reinforces key information.

#### **PRODUCTIVE TASKS**

Engage the students' imaginations and productive skills, either individually or in teams.







## **Excursions**

Excursions are fun and exciting activities outside the classroom, giving students a chance to explore and experience the area. They provide opportunities to learn and make new friends.

For practice, students will be required to communicate fully in English with each other, unless otherwise necessary.

Some excursions involve tasks that students need to cooperate on teams to complete.











Each evening will feature a planned activity for students who would like to join. Participation is optional, and students are free to use the time as they please.

The exception is the final evening on July 27th, in which students are required to join the camp closing ceremony, where they will also receive their certificates.

### Pre-departure Checklist

- ✓ Travel insurance to cover the full duration of the camp (Saturday, July 22nd-Thursday, July 27th). If you will be in Thailand longer, we recommend travel insurance to cover your full stay.
- Return flight booked for date within permitted period of stay. Check official Thai immigration information or inquire with us for details.
- Spending money (evening meal, leisure time activities, shopping, etc.). Recommended minimum: 1000 Thai baht per day.
- ✓ Any necessary medications or medical devices.
- Swimwear and beach towel (if you want to swim!)
- ✓ Sun protection (hat, sunscreen, sunglasses).
  These can also be purchased once in Thailand.
