Classes

UK-THEMED LESSONS

ENGLISH SKILLS COMPONENTS

Introduce useful language for understanding and discussing the content of the day's lesson.

Quiz the students' knowledge of the lesson and reinforces key information.

Engage the students' imaginations and productive skills, either individually or in teams.

Pre-departure Checklist

- ✓ Travel insurance to cover the full duration of the camp (Saturday, July 22nd – Thursday, July 27th). If you will be in Thailand longer, we recommend travel insurance to cover your full stay.
- ✓ Return flight booked for date within permitted period of stay. Check official Thai immigration information or inquire with us for details.
- ✓ Spending money (evening meal, leisure time activities, shopping, etc.). Recommended minimum: 1000 Thai baht per day.
- ✓ Any necessary medications or medical devices.
- ✓ Swimwear and beach towel (if you want to swim!)
- ✓ Sun protection (hat, sunscreen, sunglasses). These can also be purchased once in Thailand.
